Tonight you received a message from Chancellor Marshall regarding a campus closure for Monday and Tuesday of this week. Because the situation with COVID-19 is evolving at a rapid pace, we have decided to close the Cypress College campus to employees, students, and the general public on Monday and Tuesday. This will be the case for all North Orange County Community College District offices and locations. All employees will be in paid status.

This is an unprecedented decision, but it was done to meet the concerns of our employees and needs of our campus community. At this time, we are continuing our plans to resume remote instruction on Wednesday, as well as limited services for students, but need to assess the impact this will have on the campus and our employees. Please be available for any remote meetings that may be scheduled throughout the work day. Zoom meetings already scheduled will also take place, unless you are notified otherwise. Additional updates will be sent on Monday.

As always, our Campus Safety and M&O staff have already worked to make sure the campus is secure. Please continue to watch your email, the website, and our social media for updates. We care for your welfare and thank you for your professionalism and patience during this crisis.
