The Senate reserves the right to change the order of the agenda items as the need arises.

AGENDA:

- I. Establish Quorum and Acknowledge Alternates**
 - A. Establishment of quorum at 3:05pm
 - B. No alternates

- II. Adoption of the Agenda**
 - A. Motion to adopt the agenda as written by Senator Estrada. Motion seconded by Senator McAlister. The motion was passed unanimously.

- III. COVID-19 Response Planning (60 min.)** Craig Goralski
 - A. Eileen Haddad reviewed the Impact of EW on Spring 2020 grade trends, document comparison to Spring 2019 grades, and the comparison of the approach between Cypress and Fullerton. Discussion on how this will impact us going forward. President Goralski asked senate to review policies and be prepared to speak about them in the next meeting.
 - B. Discussion on the Return to Work Guide document for Fall 2020 and possibly Spring 2021. Senators and Liaisons shared their concerns with the document. President Goralski directed senators to ask their divisions with classes in fall to review the guide, find out who will be sharing space and how is that going to be addressed in the fall, and any feedback on the document.
 - C. Curriculum Chair Grote shared that the curriculum committee has discussed the P/NP policies.
 - D. Liaison Diep solicited senate feedback as needed

- IV. The Senate’s Role in Promoting Equity, Diversity, Inclusion, Anti-Racism and Social Justice (60 min.)** Craig Goralski
 - A. President Goralski requested the emphasis to be on action this year in promoting equity, diversity, inclusion, anti-racism and social justice at the

- campus and district levels. Discussion of Cypress College participation in the California Community College Equity Leadership Alliance.
- B. President Goralski suggested to institute a dedicated college hour for a structured time and place for more participation from campus. Senate is asked to provide feedback on this topic in future meetings.
 - C. Following discussion, Curriculum Chair Grote made a motion to direct President Goralski to ask Arturo Ocampo, District Director for Diversity and Compliance, to join the senate for the July 23rd meeting to review the recommendations that were made by the senate in Spring 2018 with regard to equity and faculty hiring. Motion was seconded by Steven Estrada. The motion was passed unanimously. During debate, Steven moved to amend the motion to include asking Arturo to share the results of the faculty of color survey that was done. Motion was seconded by Kathleen McAlister. The amended motion was passed unanimously.
 - D. Discussion on the role of senate in engagement and input in what we do going forward in terms of action in promoting equity, diversity, inclusion, anti-racism and social justice. A motion was made by Senator Estrada for senate to direct President Goralski to engage with the leadership and membership of the various employee groups Asian-American/Pacific Islander Faculty and Staff Sssociation, Black Faculty and Staff Association, Latino Staff and Faculty Association and have those conversations between now and July to inform before our meeting on the 29th. The motion was amended by Senator Angelov to include the Middle Eastern Staff and Faculty. The motion was additionally amended by Senator Robertson to include GLADE. The amended motion was passed unanimously.
 - E. Discussion on Board President Ryan Bent comments. President Goralski asked for a sense of senate, asking if the senate is in agreement that the statements made trustee Ryan Bent are inappropriate and he should use any mechanism at his disposal to reject those statement and to bring about change at the board level and to improve the board. The sense of the senate was unanimous.
