Two of the state's premiere colleges and one of the most extensive continuing education programs combine to provide the quality educational programming of the North Orange County Community College District (NOCCCD). Nearly 56,000 students enroll each term at Cypress College, Fullerton College, and North Orange Continuing Education (NOCE). College students are able to shape their futures in programs leading to associate degrees, career certificates, and transfer opportunities. Life-long learning also is possible in continuing education programs that range from high school completion and basic skills mastery through an array of career technical training and self-development courses. The NOCCCD campuses serve an area of over one million diverse people—each pursuing their own, unique ambitions.

The District encompasses approximately 155 square miles. Boundaries extend to the Riverside County line on the east and the Los Angeles County line on the west and north. A portion of Los Angeles County, on the north and west boundary, is included in the District's service area.

Fullerton College Students Ride FREE!



As of fall 2019, all Fullerton College students have access to free, unlimited Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) bus rides on all OC Bus local fixed routes. Full-time and part-time students can access this benefit by downloading the OC Bus mobile application on their smartphone device or activating their student ID card to use as a bus pass. From August 2019 to January 2020, the OCTA Bus Pass Program at Fullerton College recorded 111,921 student boardings.

The first year of the three-year pilot program was funded by a grant OCTA was awarded from State cap-and-trade funds, available through the Low Carbon Transit Operations Program, as well as from the Mobile Source Air Pollution Review Committee. Fall 2020 through summer 2022, the program will be paid by fees approved by Fullerton College students in April 2019. The typical cost to ride the OC Bus system is \$2 per ride, \$5 per day, and \$185 for a full-semester student bus pass; therefore, students who utilize the program to ride the bus see substantial savings over the course of the semester.

"I am so proud of the work Associated Students, Fullerton College staff and our partners at OCTA have done to help address a critical student need," said Fullerton College President Greg Schulz. "Access to free public transportation throughout Orange County not only helps our students get to and from campus, but also helps them with transportation for personal and job-related use. I hope many students take advantage of the program."

The OCTA Bus Pass Program began at Santa Ana College in 2017. The program has introduced new riders to public transit and allowed access to higher education for students, some who have said that they wouldn't be able to attend college without it. The program also launched at Golden West College in Huntington Beach and is now available at four OC campuses—also including Santiago Canyon College.
