These interrelated challenges can be addressed with interdisciplinary responses and sustainable solutions benefitting both humanity and nature. The mission of the Global Citizenship Studies Program is to enable students to understand how globalization, climate change, decreasing biodiversity, and ongoing social, economic and political inequities are interconnected, and to develop foundational and advanced skills from multiple disciplines for sustainable solutions. Strategies will be learned, developed and practiced for transforming local and global challenges into workable resolutions. This is an interdisciplinary program, drawing from the social sciences, natural sciences, the arts and humanities, as well as career technical fields. To earn an Associate Degree students must complete: (1) 21 units with a grade of C or better; (2) Cypress College Native General Education requirements; California State University General Education Breadth requirements (CSU GE Breadth) or IGETC General Education requirements, including the cultural diversity and reading requirements and any elective courses to complete a minimum of 60 units; and, (3) have a minimum GPA of 2.0.
