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STEP 1: CYPRESS COLLEGE APPLICATION

- ! Apply online @ www.cypresscollege.edu
- ! Select the current semester
- ! (Complete the form as if you have already graduated high school)

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STEP 2: DSPS PAPERWORK

- ! Come to our office to fill out required paperwork to start a file.
- ! Bring any available documentation of your disability (**IEP, PSYCHOLOGICAL REPORT, OR MEDICAL VERIFICATION, UNOFFICIAL HIGH SCHOOL AND COLLEGE TRANSCRIPTS**).

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STEP 3: ASSESSMENT

- ! Make an appointment to take your English, ESL, and Math placement tests in our office.
- ! **If you have already taken the placements tests in the Assessment Center, you cannot retake them in our office.*
- ! Make an appointment to meet with one of our Academic Counselors for counseling and orientation.

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STEP 4: COUNSELING/ORIENTATION

- ! Bring transcripts from high school and other colleges to your meeting with one of our Academic Counselors.
- ! At this appointment we will discuss placement testing results, eligible services, class scheduling, advising and referrals.

STEP 5: FINANCIAL AID

- ! Fee waiver (BOGW) form may be obtained online at www.cccapply.org/BOG_Waiver/
- ! Federal financial aid (FAFSA) is available online at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
