## Women's Soccer Team Tops in Nation

### ► The team jumps past Long Beach City in the latest national poll.

Cypress College women's soccer team has moved to the top of the national top-15 poll provided by the National Soccer Coaches Association of America.

The Lady Chargers jumped to the top of the poll after Long Beach City played a 1-1 tie with Mt. San Antonio.

The Chargers had a glossy 13-0 record headed into last Friday's home game against Saddleback College.

Late last week, the women's soccer team moved to the top of the state poll, by the California Community College Soccer Coaches Association, with a 12-0 record. Following that poll, the Chargers recorded a home victory over District-rival Fullerton.

The NSCAA conducts the

most widely recognized national and regional soccer ranking system in the country as a service to the general public and its members. The intent of the rankings program is to stimulate greater interest in men's and women's soccer and to recognize those programs that are enjoying remarkable success on a regional and national level.

## Construction Corner: Updates on Several Projects

As part of the planning for the “campus remodel for efficiency” bond project, a team of architects and construction managers conducted a walk-through of Fine Arts and Science/Engineering/Math last week.

The purpose was to examine the conditions in each building as part of a needs assesment. With the buildings being 35 years old, there were many needs identified.

The next scheduled date for walk-throughs is October 30, from 9 a.m.-5 p.m. The plan is for the remaining buildings to be addressed at that time.

The walk-throughs are the first step of a process that will culminate in classrooms across the campus that function for the needs of today and tomorrow. The first step of remodeling will be complete after estimates are received for work that is needed.

The second step of the process —

which is now beginning — is the updating of the educational master plan. A packet will be sent out to each department coordinator to review and respond, regarding their educational programs. Once this information is received, then the architects will start meeting with the divisions to help them discuss and prioritize needs.

Here are updates on other projects:

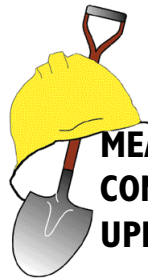
- The theater renovation is moving along nicely and should be ready by the end of the semester.

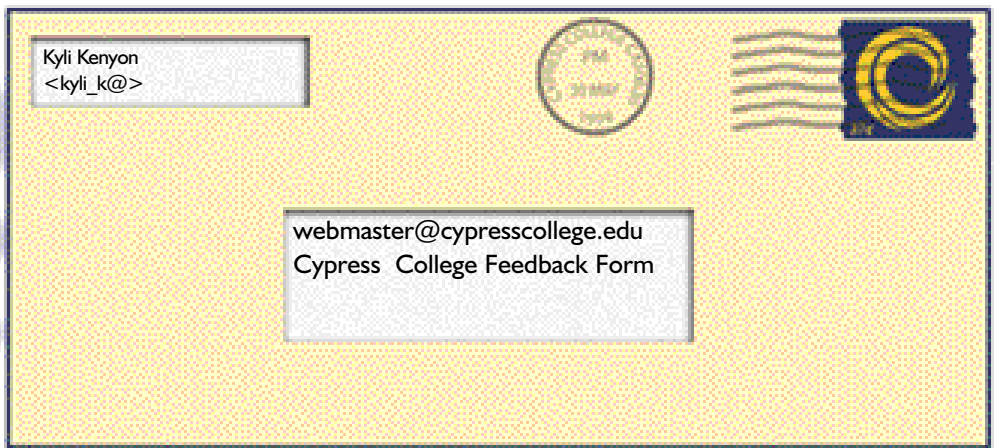
