## Gas Co. Sponsors KinderCaminata on Friday

► **The utility company becomes the event's first title sponsor with \$2,500.**

KinderCaminata will go on one week from today in large part to a generous contribution of \$2,500 from The Gas Company.

The donation makes the utility the first title sponsor for the event, which brings more than 1,000 local kindergarten students to campus for their first day of college.

KinderCaminata is intended to instill in the visiting students, at a time when they're just starting school, the expectation that they will one day complete a university degree.

Funds from the donation will cover just about all of the event's expenses. Knott's Southern California Resort and their vendors combined to provide a donation of food for the children's lunches.

The visiting students will explore potential careers at booths staffed by college employees and members of the local community.

Among the participating divisions, Vocational Technical will be the most represented with displays from across their curriculum. Automotive is bringing an alternative-fuel vehicle and Aviation is displaying a glider.

Health Science, Physical Education, and Language Arts are among the other participants.

As usual, the young visitors will also have the opportunity to crawl through a police car and will watch a demonstration from the fire department.

Music, dancing and a musician are also on tap.

## Half-Semester Classes Start the Week of March 22

The semester is about half over — and that means that the popular 9-week "Half-Semester" program is about to begin. Classes start the week of March 22.

Capacity in many of the classes has been expanded, so it is important to make sure that students are aware that they may now be able to get into a class that was previously full.

Among those with extra seats, are several from the Social Science Division: ANTH 102 (CRN 23787), GEOG 100 (CRN 23790), HIST 170 (CRN 24034), HIST 171 (CRN 22736), POSC 100 (CRN 23254), PHIL 100 (CRN 22049), and PSY 101 (CRN 22814).

Since the college needs to expand enrollment to meet the target, it is important to encourage students to take advantage of this opportunity to take an extra class now.

It may also be to their economic benefit considering the state proposal to increase enrollment fees from \$18 per unit to \$26.
