## Touched By Hurricane Katrina, Campus Creates a Relief Fund

► **Donations of cash and checks will be collected for two weeks at the Health Center for distribution to the Red Cross fund.**

The stories of devastation, heartbreak and total loss coming out of the Gulf States have moved members of the Cypress College community to begin a relief fund that will be presented to the Red Cross Hurricane Katrina Relief Fund.

The effort — dubbed “I Made a CD” — is spearheaded by Mary Lou Giska, director of the campus Health Center.

“Many years ago, my family and I lived in LaPlace, Louisiana, a short distance from New Orleans. I worked at a hospital in New Orleans. It was (is) a wonderful city, filled with many good and caring people,” she said. “We also lived in Jackson, Mississippi. Again, a part of the country filled with friendly, caring, outgoing people.

Now the smiling faces are replaced by hopelessness and despair. I don’t think any of us can even begin to imagine what these people are going through.”

Beginning Tuesday, September 5 until Friday, September 16, Cypress College will hold a Hurricane Katrina Relief Fund “I Made a CD” campaign. The “CD” stands for “Caring Donation.”

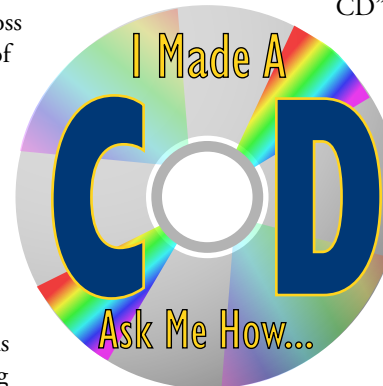
Cash or checks (made out to the Cypress College Foundation) can be dropped off at the Health Center, where they will then be deposited into an account open for the Hurricane Relief donations. Receipts are available for donations made at the health center.

At the end of the campaign, a check from Cypress College will be donated to the Red Cross Hurricane Katrina Relief Fund.

Because of logistic concerns, only cash or checks will be collected; no food or clothing.

Among those impacted by Katrina are a number of community colleges in Louisiana, Mississippi, and Alabama

— some of which may not be able to offer any instruction this academic year.



### E-mail Scam Plays off Katrina Tragedy

A suspicious e-mail with the subject title, “Re: p1 80 people killed,” or a variation of it has been circulating around the Web. The body of the e-mail contains information regarding Hurricane Katrina with a “read more” hyperlink at the bottom. Do not click on the hyperlink. Delete the e-mail. This appears to be some sort of “phishing” attack in hopes that your concern over the recent tragedy in the Gulf states may entice you to click on the link. Once the link has been accessed, malicious software may be downloaded to your PC. If you have any questions, please call the IS Helpdesk at ext. 84849.

### Add ‘ICE’ to Your Cell Phone

Cell phone users are being urged to put the acronym ICE — “in case of emergency” — before the names of the people they want to designate as next of kin in their cell phone address book, creating entries such as “ICE — Dad” or “ICE — Alison.” Paramedics, police and firefighters often waste valuable time trying to figure out which name in a cell phone to call when disaster strikes, according to current and retired members of the emergency services. ## New Study: Community Colleges Increase Earning Power of Students

According to a recently published study by Marcotte, Bailey, Borkoski, and Kienzel, new statistics were revealed regarding the positive correlation between economic benefits and education in the community college sector.

Their econometric analysis of 7,021 students from the 2000 follow-up of the National Education Longitudinal Survey led to the following conclusions among others:

- "We estimated that, on average, young men who enrolled in a community or technical college earned approximately 6% more annually for each year

of FTE [full-time equivalent] coursework completed even when they did not obtain a degree [associate or bachelor's]..."

- "...men who had obtained an associate degree earned about 14.7% more annually... than their peers with a high school education..."

- Respectively, "women who had associate degrees earned about 47.6% more annually... than their peers with a high school education" and "...women earned 11.1% more per year... for each FTE year of study in a community college..."

## 'Edge of Air' Exhibit Features Images of El Toro Base's Final Days

The Edge of Air exhibit, which features photographs of the final days of the Marine Corps Air Station at El Toro by the Legacy Project, is now on display in the Photography Galleries, located in Tech Ed I and the third floor of the Library.

The non-profit Legacy Project consists of six well-known regional photographers: Jerry Burchfield, Mark Chamberlain, Jacques Garnier, Robert Johnson, Douglas McCulloh, and Clayton Spada. Four are faculty members on campus. These artists are dedicated to producing documentary and aesthetically oriented photographs of the now-shuttered MCAS El Toro and its transition into the Orange County Great Park.

A reception and book signing will be held on Tuesday, September 6, from 7 to 9 p.m., on the second floor of the Tech Ed I.

## Blueprint

A report on Cypress College's Construction Projects

Now everyone knows just how the "piazza-eating dinosaur" looked and sounded this summer as a portion of the upper level was removed to make way for the new Student Center. The machine returned this week to finish the final piece of the job. Once cleanup is completed, two pedestrian paths that were closed near the pool will re-open to improve pedestrian access across the campus. The current campus map — dated August 25 — is located on the campus Web site. When the paths re-open, a new version of the map will be distributed and posted to CypressCollege.edu. It will closely match maps dated August 16, so those can be distributed as well.

Work on the exterior of the Library/Learning Resource is visible as crews add the skin to the new building. The areas that aren't currently closed in will be glass, so it's easier to now get a good sense of how the L/LRC will look when it's completed.

Crews are also making progress in front of the Science/Engineering/Math building along the front of the pond. Once piping and cement work are completed, that pathway can re-open.

The hard work of the M&O staff is apparent in front of the Student Activities Center, where there is green grass growing again around the small pond.
