


Understanding Your Financial Aid Status in MyGateway



Students in good standing typically graduate and transfer on time. Maintaining good standing is essential if you plan on receiving financial aid when you transfer. Be sure to review the "Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress" policy at your preferred transfer institution so you can ensure your long-term eligibility if you plan on receiving aid while completing a Bachelor's degree.



Students on financial aid warning (FAWARN) are provided one semester to improve their academic performance before being disqualified. Students who have exceeded the maximum timeframe are automatically disqualified and do not receive a warning semester. PRO1 status refers to students with an approved appeal who must meet specific conditions outlined by the financial aid office to maintain their eligibility.

Disqualified



Disqualified (DISQ) students are provided specific instructions regarding the appeals process, timeline, and procedures for requesting additional eligibility via email and myGateway. Be sure to verify the number of units required for your academic program. Programs that require fewer than 60 units (certificate programs) have a maximum timeframe of less than 90 units.



- All financial aid applicants are expected to comply with the Satisfactory Academic Progress policy you sign when completing your file with the Financial Aid Office.
- Your academic performance is reviewed at the end of each semester.
- All units <u>attempted</u> and <u>completed</u> from all institutions attended are calculated for financial aid purposes (regardless of previous institutions attended).
- You are notified of your current financial aid status via email after your grades post in MyGateway.
