- **USC STUDENTS:** Once you have enrolled at USC, you cannot take transfer courses to fulfill GE or the writing requirement. Only with a completed pre-approval form from USC, you may take transfer courses in the summer to fulfill global perspectives or language, obtain equivalence, or elective units.
