RESTRICTIONS:

- **Students still in high school:** College courses taken *before high school* graduation cannot be used to fulfill any of the requirements listed below except for GE categories 1, 2, 3, and 5.
- **USC STUDENTS:** Once you have enrolled at USC, *you cannot take transfer courses to fulfill GE or the writing requirement.* Only with a completed pre-approval form from USC, you may take transfer courses in the summer to fulfill diversity or language, obtain equivalence, or elective units.

TRANSFERABLE GENERAL EDUCATION: Students may fulfill categories 1, 2, 3, 5, the lower division writing, diversity, and language requirements with transfer courses taken before starting USC. You may fulfill each requirement by completing one of the courses (or a set of two courses, if indicated by "with") listed under that requirement below. Categories 4 and 6 must be taken at USC.
